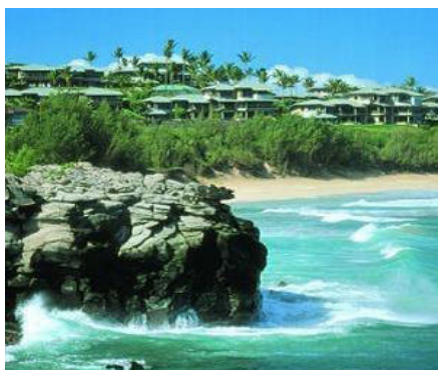

Upon arrival you will be transferred to your accommodation at the Kapalua Villas Resort.

Nestled between the spectacular Maui coastline and the rolling hills of a lush pineapple plantation, lie The Kapalua Villas. Private lanais open onto magnificent views of the lush green fairways or across the water to the island of Molokai shimmering on the horizon. Each unit is tastefully decorated and complete with a fully equipped kitchen, ceiling fans and washer/dryers. Several outdoor freshwater pools, outdoor tennis courts and a variety of restaurants amply assist in filling those après-golf hours.

THURSDAY **20 MAY**

MAUI – KAPALUA - THE BAY COURSE

The par-72, 6,600-yard layout designed by Arnold Palmer and Francis Duane, is tropical in atmosphere and friendly to all levels of play. Winding through palms and hibiscus, this course rolls gently to the sea - with all putts breaking to the neighbour island of Molokai shimmering on the horizon. On a lava peninsula that carves two pristine bays, Hole #4 has ocean breezes and uninterrupted views of the coast. The Bay Course signature Hole #5 asks you to carry over sparkling Oneloa Bay to a small green protected by sand traps. Your package includes unlimited golf today so you can play another 9 or 18 holes at your leisure if you want.

MAUI / LANAI / MAUI

This morning you will take the short ferry ride across to the island.

Golf at The Challenge at Manele GC.

Carved out of the rugged coast, the Challenge at Manele sprawls across ancient lava fields, with 180-degree ocean panoramas from every hole. A theatre of color unfolds: red cliffs plunging down to blue sea, green fairways engulfing white sandtraps, and blossoms from fissures in the black lava rock. This was the palette of designer Jack Nicklaus, who shaped the 7,039-yard, par 72 championship course, carefully protecting and preserving the archaeological ruins within its borders.

Return to Maui via Ferry.

MAUI- KAPALUA – THE PLANTATION COURSE

The par-73, 7,263-yard Plantation Course is the course of the champions, site of the PGA TOUR season-opening Mercedes Championships each January. The grand scale of the course designed by Ben Crenshaw and Bill Coore unfurls across natural geographic formations and pineapple plantation fields that take your breath away.

Again today you can play another 9 or 18 holes at your leisure as unlimited golf is included in your package.

MAUI / WAIKIKI

This morning you will be transferred to Maui Airport where you will board your short flight to Honolulu.

Honolulu International Airport (HNL)

Upon arrival you will be transferred to your accommodation the Ohana Waikiki Beachcomber. The heart of Waikiki beats with excitement as the renewed Ohana Waikiki Beachcomber hotel creates a new gathering place for contemporary comfort, camaraderie and fun! This well known location overlooking Kalakaua Avenue unveils a unique concept that rolls with live music, great food and good times. The hotel is adjacent to the open-air International Market Place, just steps to designer fashion and multi-cultural dining at Royal Hawaiian Center, and an easy stroll to Waikiki Beach.

The rest of the afternoon is at leisure.

MONDAY 24 MAY

WAIKIKI- WAIALAE COUNTRY CLUB

This morning you will be transferred to the Waialae Country Club. The 18-hole "Waialae" course at the Waialae Country Club facility in Honolulu, Hawaii features 7,012 yards of golf from the longest tees for a par of 72 . The course rating is 73.2 and it has a slope rating of 133. Designed by Seth Raynor, the Waialae golf course opened in 1927.

Tour Prices: Tour prices are based on costs in effect at 15 December 2009. Costs will also depend on availability of hotels quoted on at time of booking. These costs are subject to the group travelling together throughout the tour. Any variation will incur an amendment fee and may also jeopardise the costs for the rest of the group. Prices are based on the tour numbers stipulated on the itinerary. Any change in tour numbers will result in a revised tour price. NB. Cancelled rooms may result in 100% cancellation fees from hotels.

Payments Schedule :

Initial Deposit - At time of booking : \$500.00 per person (bookings will be made when deposit has been received in our office)

Interim Payment -6 months prior to departure: \$500.00 per person

Final Tour Payment – 1st April 2010

Cancellation charges per tour member: (Notice of cancellation must be made in writing)

Time of booking - 6 months prior to departure : \$200.00 per person

6 – 2 months prior to departure: \$400.00 per person

2 – 1 month prior to departure: 50% of total tour cost (airport taxes are refundable)

1 month prior to departure and after commencement of travel: Nil Refund

Please note there may be specialised inclusions in your tour such as Train Tickets, Theatre Show tickets, instant purchase airline tickets etc that are non-refundable in addition to the above Cancellation Charges. These cancellation fees are in addition to any cancellation fees that may be levied by our tour suppliers.

Amendment Fee : Any person wishing to amend from the group tour arrangements will be charged a standard \$110.00 amendment fee per person plus any additional charges involved with the amendment (increase in airfare, additional transfers, accommodation etc).

Documentation: Australian citizens require a passport with minimum 6 months validity from date of departure from final destination. Other passport holders may require additional documentation. Please check your applicable requirements with our Travel Consultant. A copy of each person's passport is required.

Baggage: Free baggage allowance one piece weighing maximum 20 kg plus 1 cabin bag (piece) of 115cm with a maximum weight of 5kg per person (please note these restrictions vary between airlines & depends on your destination). Luggage in excess of these limits will be charged for at the appropriate excess baggage rates. Baggage is the responsibility of the passenger at all times (Travel Insurance is strongly recommended).

Insurance Protection: We strongly recommend you take out a Travel Insurance policy which is available from Gullivers Sport Travel. Policy booklets are available from Gullivers Sport Travel.

Airline & Airport Taxes, Surcharges & Levies : Are not included in the tour cost as they are continually changing. Any of these charges imposed by the airline will be notified to you at the time of final payment 2 months prior to departure.
