THURSDAY **29 SEPTEMBER** **SYDNEY, BRISBANE, MELBOURNE / CHRISTCHURCH**

Depart Australia.

On arrival in Christchurch you will be met and transferred to your 3 star accommodation where you will stay for the next 3 nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

FRIDAY **30 SEPTEMBER** **CHRISTCHURCH**

Today there will be a full day tour to Kaikoura for whale watching. Alternatively you may like to enjoy lunch in one of the many restaurants.

An iconic city square and cathedral, a historic tram, wide tree-lined avenues and restored heritage buildings make Christchurch a picture-perfect destination. Known as the Garden City, Christchurch has a distinctive quaint character, with over 740 parks and the meandering Avon River. Christchurch is a vibrant city, with a lively café scene and plenty of museums and culture venues to keep locals and tourists entertained.

SATURDAY **01 OCTOBER** **CHRISTCHURCH**

Today you will attend the **AUSTRALIA VS RUSSIA** fixture.

SUNDAY **02 OCTOBER** **CHRISTCHURCH / DUNEDIN**

After breakfast at your hotel you will join your tour coach and driver for a 5 day inclusive charter.

Transfer to Dunedin where you will stay for the next 2 nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

This afternoon you will attend the **IRELAND VS ITALY** fixture.

Dunedin is a vibrant city offering some amazing outdoor activities. Walk, cycle, kayak or take a tour of the Otago Peninsula. Thirty minutes from the CBD, the Otago peninsula is home to unique New Zealand wildlife. Here you will see yellow eyed penguins, the only mainland albatross breeding colony, New Zealand fur seals, sea lions and much more.

MONDAY 03 OCTOBER

DUNEDIN

Today there will be a full day sightseeing tour of Dunedin, Otago Peninsula & Speights Brewery where you will enjoy lunch.

TUESDAY 04 OCTOBER

DUNEDIN / QUEENSTOWN

This morning after check out, transfer to Queenstown where you will stay for the next 3 nights on a bed and breakfast basis.

Queenstown's main draws are its stunning surroundings and the incredible selection of adventure sports on offer.

The whole south island of New Zealand is blessed with many beautiful landscapes, but Queenstown is located in a particularly idyllic spot on the shores of Lake Wakatipu, surrounded by the Remarkables and Eyre mountain ranges. In winter, these mountains make Queenstown a key destination for the world's skiers and snowboarders, who visit the ski fields by day and take advantage of the town's many bars and clubs by night.

WEDNESDAY 05 OCTOBER

Today there will be a full day Milford Sound excursion to include a cruise and lunch.

THURSDAY 06 OCTOBER

QUEENSTOWN

Your coach is available for the many activities of Queenstown such as the Gondola ride, the Shotover Jet or a cruise on the lake.

FRIDAY 07 OCTOBER

QUEENSTOWN / WELLINGTON

This morning transfer to Queenstown Airport for your flight to Wellington.

On arrival in Wellington, transfer to your hotel where you will stay for the next 3 nights on a bed & breakfast basis.

Located on the southwestern tip of the North Island, Wellington, the capital of New Zealand, enjoys a beautiful natural setting, nestled between a picturesque harbour and rolling green hills. SUNDAY 09 OCTOBER

WELLINGTON

Today you will attend the Rugby World Cup 2011, New Zealand quarter-final 3. It is likely this will be South Africa v Ireland.

WINNER POOL D VS RUNNER UP POOL C

Make your own way to and from the stadium with local transportation today.

MONDAY 10 OCTOBER

WELLINGTON / SYDNEY, MELBOURNE or BRISBANE

Today you will transfer to Wellington Airport for your return flight back to Australia.

The Company reserves the right to cancel the tour and/or modify the itineraries in any way it thinks desirable and further reserves the right to decline to accept any person or any tour and may substitute hotels where necessary. The issuance and acceptance or receipts, tickets, vouchers, coupons or travel orders shall be deemed consent to the above.

Tour Prices: The costs for all tours are based on current airline schedules, airfares and a minimum of 40 passengers traveling together on each tour coach. Land costs are based on an exchange rate of 1.30 (selling rate) against the New Zealand Dollar. Tour costs shown are subject to alteration (up or down) due to exchange rate fluctuations and increases in land and air costs which arise prior to receipt of final payment. Costs will also depend on availability of hotels quoted on. Tour prices are sold as a complete package. Alterations and deviations during the tour itinerary will not be accepted.

Prices for Travel Arrangements: All travel arrangements booked for the passenger/s have been based on costs at the time of booking and are subject to change in accordance with advice from the service suppliers regarding changes to airfares, fluctuation of exchange rates, increases levied by the service suppliers or variations in the itinerary caused by cancellation or curtailment of services or rescheduling. The passenger agrees to pay any such additional charges prior to departure and prior to ticketing time limits and travel departure date.

Tax invoices will be issued prior to the relevant due dates – late payment may result in the cancellation of your reservation and will be subject to cancellation fees. Deposit and payment conditions for extended travel arrangements will be advised when bookings are requested.

Cancellation penalties: All deposits and further payments are non refundable. In no circumstances will any monies paid under this Agreement be refunded by the company to the Passenger. Passengers will not be entitled to a refund for any unused services after commencement date of their trip. It is therefore strongly recommended that passengers take out suitable travel insurance including a clause covering cancellation penalties.

Amendment Fee: Any person wishing to amend from the group tour arrangements before or after the tour package must notify Gullivers Sport Travel in writing and will be charged a standard \$100.00 amendment fee per person plus any additional charges involved with the amendment (increase in airfare, additional transfers, accommodation etc). Please note that your deviation may be subject to airline / supplier season changes and may incur additional costs, surcharges & taxes. All tours are sold on the basis that no tour can be altered for an individual or group between the tour start and finish date.

Documentation: All passengers travelling on an Australian passport must have a passport valid until their return date to Australia. Passengers traveling on a passport other than an Australian passport must advise Gullivers Sport Travel to ensure you meet visa requirements overseas and on your return to Australia. Visa requirements are the passengers own responsibility. Please ensure all names provided to us are as per the passengers passports.

Baggage: Free baggage allowance one piece weighing maximum 20 kg plus 1 cabin bag (piece) of 115cm with a maximum weight of 5kg per person (economy class). Luggage in excess of these limits will be charged at the appropriate excess baggage rates by the airline. Baggage is the responsibility of the passenger at all times (Travel Insurance is strongly recommended).

Travel Insurance Protection: Travel insurance is strongly advised for all tour members. Brochures detailing coverage are available from Gullivers Sport Travel's preferred insurer and will be forwarded to you on request.

Accommodation : If you are wanting to share with another tour member we will endeavour to meet your request. However in the event that this it is not possible then the single room supplement must be paid. Please note: hotels & locations mentioned in itineraries are subject to change due to the high demand of accommodation over Rugby World Cup 2011.

Airport Taxes (Departure, Arrival, Security & Government taxes etc): Are not included in the tour cost as they are continually changing ie. due to exchange rate fluctuations, adding & deleting of taxes etc. Taxes will be advised and payable at the time of final payment.
