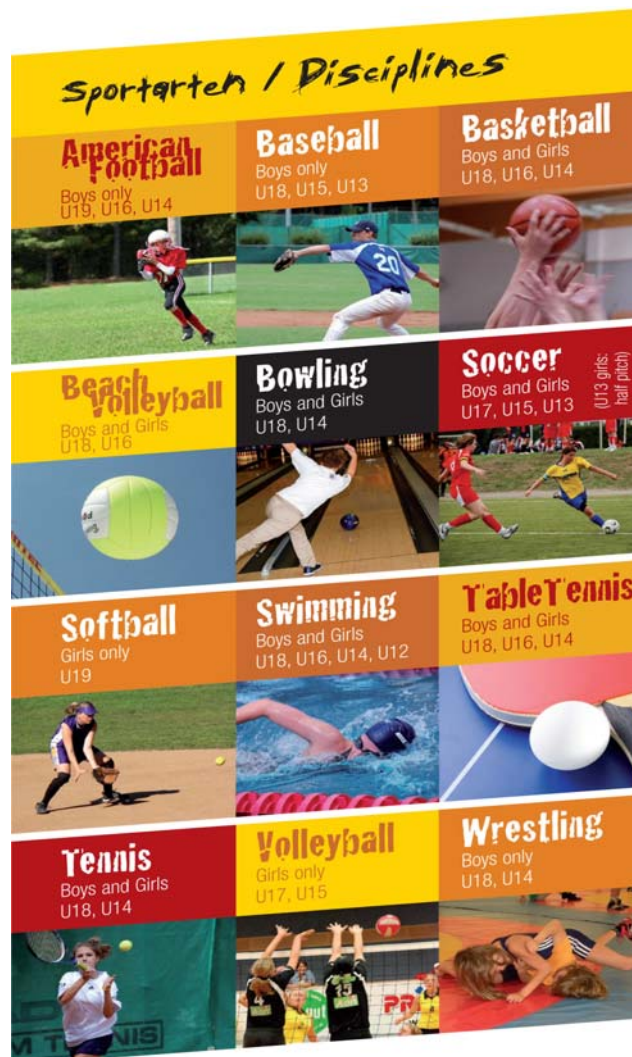

## ABOUT THE WORLD SPORTS FESTIVAL

The World Sports Festival is a unique sport event for young people and athletes. In 2008 more than 3,000 enthusiastic young people from 21 nations took part in the contests under the patronage of UNESCO.

For three days athletes will compete against, cheer on and celebrate with each other in sporting activities such as baseball, soccer, football, wrestling, swimming, tennis, volleyball and beach volleyball.

The atmosphere of the festival is not only concerned with hundredths of seconds, goals and points. What makes this event so special is the unique opportunity to meet and make friends with people from all across the world during the evening events at the heart of the festival – the player's town.

The World Sports Festival is a place where colour of skin, religion or origin does not matter!

### **Patronage - UNESCO**

The official patronage of the Sporting Festival for 2009 (2010 still to be confirmed) is UNESCO (United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization).

We are proud to welcome 12 experts in professional sports from the United States at the World Sports Festival 2009 (2010 still to be confirmed). The so-called "**All-Star Head Coaches**" will take part in the festival and thus enhance the tournaments through their presence.

**Ceal Barry – Girls Basketball:** Assistant Coach of Olympic Team (Gold) in 1996.

**Rollie MASSIMINO – Boys Basketball:** One of the most successful and experienced Basketball College Coaches in the United States. More than 500 wins with his teams in the NCAA.

**Dr. David Porter – Tennis:** Dr. Porter is amongst the most successful tennis coaches in the US College Tennis. He has also worked as a consultant for the China Tennis Association and works with China's national teams.

**Steve Sampson – Boys Soccer:** Head Coach USA national team (1995-1998). Head Coach Costa Rica National Soccer Team (2002-2004). Former head coach of Los Angeles Galaxy (2004-2006.)

**Tiffany Milbrett – Girls Soccer:** Player of the US national soccer team (1991 – 2006) Olympic gold medal in women's soccer in Atlanta 1996 Olympic silver medal in women's soccer in Sydney 2000

**Jeff Nelson – Baseball:** He continues to hold the record in Seattle for most games pitched (383). Four World Series titles with the Yankees

**Laura BERG – Softball:** Laura Berg is a three-time U.S. Olympic gold medalist in softball (1996, 2000 and 2004). Olympic silver medal in softball (2008)

**Lenny KRAYZELBURG – Swimming:** 2004 Olympic gold medalist in the 4x100 Medley relay, Triple gold medalist at the 2000 Summer Olympic Games, Olympic records in both the 100m and 200m backstroke, and a world record as a member of the 4X100 relay team in Sydney. Eleven-time U.S. National Champion

**Mark RYPIEN – American Football:** Former Quarterback in the NFL (National Football League). He won Super Bowls twice with the Redskins, in 1988 and 1991, earning the MVP award.

**Russ ROSE – VOLLEYBALL:** Head volleyball coach at Penn State University. Russ Rose's .855 winning percentage is the highest in NCAA history. He never posted less than 22 wins in a season, collecting two national titles and 11 Big Ten championships.

**FRIDAY 02 JULY****AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL CITIES - MUNICH**

- Assemble at Australian International Airports where you will need to check in at least 3 hours prior to your scheduled flight departure.
- Depart Australia.

**SATURDAY 03 JULY****MUNICH**

- On arrival into Munich International Airport you will be greeted and escorted to your coach.
- Welcome to Munich the capital city of Bavaria, Germany. Munich is located on the river Isar north of the Bavarian Alps.
- There will be an orientation tour of Munich prior to arriving at your accommodation.
- Throughout the tour you will have time to explore the pedestrianized streets that are surrounding the centre of the city and the area called Marienplatz. Many of the city's main tourist attractions are in the immediate vicinity.
- You will visit the 16<sup>th</sup> century Michaelskirche with its imposing interior and the Asamkirche which is considered a masterpiece of south German Rococo architecture.
- You will also visit the oldest part of the city which is home to the original royal residence and the world famous Hofbrauhaus.
- The tour will conclude at your accommodation where group check in formalities will proceed.
- Dinner provided.

**SUNDAY 04 JULY****MUNICH - SALZBURG**

- After breakfast you will depart by coach to the beautiful city of Salzburg.
- Salzburg is the fourth largest city in Austria and its old town area called Altstadt is one of the best preserved city centre in the world. This area of Salzburg is also listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- The city is noted for its spectacular alpine setting, the birthplace of Mozart and also as the backdrop for parts of the musical and film "The Sound of Music".
- There will be an orientation tour of the city prior to arriving at your accommodation.
- Throughout the tour you will see and hear about the Dom, the Festival Hall, St. Peter's Abbey Church and its graveyards, Salzburg fortress as well as Mozart's birthplace in the famous Getreidegasse.
- Dinner provided.





### MONDAY 05 JULY

### SALZBURG - OBERTAUERN

- After breakfast the group will travel to the famous tourist destination of Obertauern.
- The group will check into the Alpine Training Camp.
- The afternoon will consist of a 3 hour training session in your particular sport with world class coaches.
- Dinner provided.

### TUESDAY 06 JULY

### OBERTAUERN

- After breakfast there will be a 3 hour training session in your particular sport with expert coaches
- The afternoon will consist of a 3 hour hiking tour in the beautiful surrounds of Obertauern.
- Dinner provided.

### WEDNESDAY 07 JULY

### OBERTAUERN - VIENNA

- Today you will depart for Vienna.
- Vienna, one of the great capitals of Europe was for centuries home to the Habsburg rulers of the Austro-Hungarian Empire. Today the empire is long gone but the reminders of the city's imperial heyday remains, carefully preserved by the tradition loving Viennese people.
- From the late 18<sup>th</sup> century, Vienna's culture, particularly its music, was famous throughout Europe due to numerous composers that lived in the city such as Mozart, Beethoven and Strauss just to name a few.
- At the tail end of the 19<sup>th</sup> century the city's artists and architects brought an artistic revolution that swept away the past and set the stage for the radically experimental art of the 20<sup>th</sup> century.
- You will check into your accommodation and have time to prepare for the Gala Dinner.



**THURSDAY 08 JULY****VIENNA**

- After breakfast you will participate in a 3 hour training session in your particular sport.
- The afternoon will consist of a sightseeing tour of Vienna and its numerous tourist attractions. Throughout the tour you will see Hofburg Palace, The Opera House, St. Stephen's Cathedral and will visit the famous Schönbrunn Palace.
- The tour will conclude back at your accommodation where you will have time to prepare for dinner and the evening Karaoke and Talent Show.

**FRIDAY 09 JULY****VIENNA**

- Today you will start the World Sports Festival and enjoy the activities with over 5,000 enthusiastic young people from 21 nations.
- Also over the next few days you will have the opportunity to meet and mix with experts in professional sports from the United States. The All Star Head Coaches will take part in the festival and will be available to give players and coaches helpful advice throughout the tournament.
- Lunch will be provided.
- At the end of the day you will be transferred back to your accommodation to prepare for the evening activities.
- The evening programme will include the Opening Ceremony followed by a Pizza and Pasta Party.

**SATURDAY 10 JULY****VIENNA**

- After breakfast you will participate in the World Sports Festival Tournament and Activities.
- Lunch will be provided.
- At the end of the day you will be transferred back to your accommodation to prepare for the evening activities.
- The evening programme will include dinner at a local food court.

**SUNDAY 11 JULY****VIENNA**
